How do we do this?

We provide training and support for wound care service improvement using the latest methods including *Lean Thinking*.

We provide a secure shared electronic wound care patient record called **LUTM**.

- LUTM allows easy access to images and data by everyone involved in wound care.
- LUTM allows wounds to be accurately assessed and measured by digital photograph in the community.
- LUTM calculates the rate of healing and can predict the time-to-healing.
- LUTM creates a secure virtual private network for those involved in wound care.
- LUTM provides easy communication, allowing advice and best practice to be shared.

How can we help you reduce wastage of wound Care products?

Audits suggest that 30% of all prescribed wound care dressings are never used. In a locality of 100,000 people this could represent an annual waste of £60,000-£90,000.

LUTM includes a local formulary and prescribing module that allows a practitioner to supply from stock and reorder replacement stock accurately.

An optional extension allows direct ordering from NHS Supplies to deliver greater cost savings.

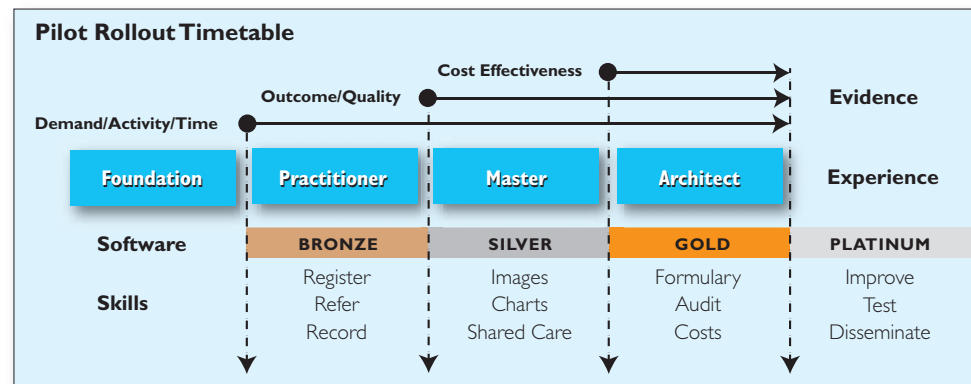

Products

We provide 3 levels of product:

- **Preview Package:** An introductory level product designed to let you see the system for yourself; experience the ease of use; and begin to observe the benefits it brings. The Preview package consists of two 6 month LUTM software licences; two digital cameras; and an introductory training and scoping session for your interested stakeholders. The objective is to have a telemedicine link up and running as soon as possible for evaluation and demonstration.
- **Pilot:** A more extensive rollout within a locality designed to link Primary, Community and Secondary care. The Pilot will allow you to evaluate the potential savings and benefits that the full WCL service can generate.
- **Procurement:** A complete PCT wide system rollout creating significant benefits for Patients (faster healing), District Nurses (released time) and a PCT (financial savings and effortless audit of the whole wound care service).
